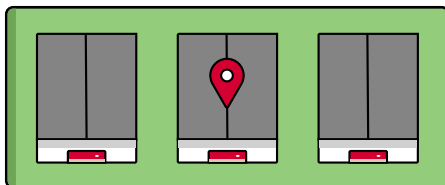

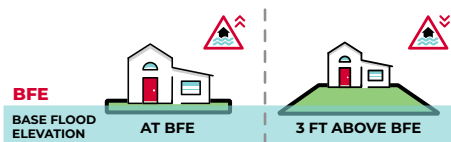

Rooftop-level geocoding pinpoints data specific to your home, not the flood zone it sits in.



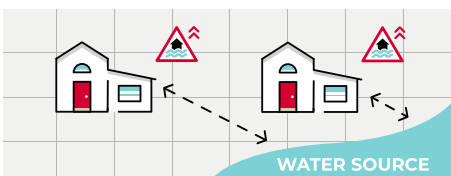
Elevation
